INSTRUCTORS

Role

To teach a specific skill/drill at a station as Coaches bring their teams to you.

What a night at camp looks like

- Camp begins at 6:30p with check-in beginning at 6P. Please arrive at 6P to the Welcome Center wearing your "Where's your joy" shirt.
- When you arrive to the Welcome Center, Nathaniel Madonna will let you know what age group you will be Instructing and where your drill is.
- As campers arrive they will head to the Auditorium until 6:40p. At 6:40p Pastor Dan will dismiss the teams to their first station.
- There are 6 stations (5 drills plus a water break) so you will most likely have 6 groups rotate through your drill. Each group will be at your station for 10 minutes. At that time the whistle will blow which will clue the Coach to collect their campers and move to the next drill (when you are inside we will use the time clock). If there is a night we are low on campers there might be a time you get a break with no group at your station.
- After all 6 rotations are completed, Coaches will take their campers and head back to the Auditorium for a closing time all together with Pastor Dan.
- At that time (if you are outside), please move all equipment into the Elementary Hall so it is safe overnight.
- Once you have cleared your station you are free to leave, or you can help with check-out or other misc items that need put away

Check-Out Process

- Pastor Dan will end "Overtime" and that will be our cue to start the check-out process. This will be a reverse of the check-in process. Have one coach stay with your team in their pew and any other coaches or assistant coaches will go to the Front Lobby to help with check-out
 - The check-out process is a volunteer will:
 - 1 / Greet a parent in line by taking their Parent Pick-Up Card and asking their child's age (it is sometimes multiple children)
 - 2 / Send parents to wait in the Welcome Center for you to meet them with their child
 - 2 / Go to the correct pew for that age team and find the camper with the correct number on their wristband that matches the card you have
 - 3 / Walk the camper to their parent and thank them for coming (go through the doors by church office).
 - 4 / Place the card in the box/on the table and repeat until all campers are picked up

Planning Center Approval

Prior to camp you will receive an email from Planning Center asking you to accept or decline participating each night at camp. Please be diligent about responding because this lets us know how many volunteers we have each night. Our hope is that you can serve at camp all week but we know there are things that can arise or other previous commitments you might have.
